The crash also had left her with vision problems and a loss of feeling on her left side.

Her condition continued to deteriorate. Her speech became jumbled. She forgot simple things, became confused and didn't recognize her children and her husband, Rich, who rushed her back to the hospital.

A specialist at the facility's concussion clinic finally delivered the diagnosis that would transform Lauren Grubb — wife, mother, en-trepreneur, artist, chef — to Lauren Grubb: traumatic brain injury patient. She was immediately admitted to a rehab hospital.
