HOW MUCH DOES PROM COST?



The price tag for a prom can vary quite a bit, and it can cost anywhere from \$200 to \$2,000, depending on your budget. Here's a breakdown of what your bill for the entire evening might look like.

\$30-\$250 HAIR/MAKEUP/NAILS

You might decide to go to a salon to get your hair, makeup or nails done, or you could opt to buy the necessary items and do it yourself.

\$60-\$400

You can keep the cost down if your mom is stitching one for you or if you are buying it at a thrift store. But you'll pay more if you shop at a department store and a lot more if it's at a one-of-a-kind boutique.

\$60-\$400 PROM TICKET

Location dictates ticket costs, but it could run \$20 to \$250. If your prom is in a fancy hotel or ballroom, it probably will cost more than if it's in your school gym.

Ticket prices usually include entry to the dance, dinner and beverages. Look into what's included with the tickets before planning a big dinner elsewhere.



\$10-\$20 BOUTONNIERE

The guy's boutonniere costs usually depend on the type of flowers.



\$30-\$125 FORMAL PHOTOGRAPHY

Prices for professional photos range from \$30 to \$125. Most prom committees arrange for a photographer to take portraits, which could be prepaid or paid at the event. So don't forget to take the money. If you want to take pictures with your phone, that's okay, too.
