

RAINFALL BY THE NUMBERS



Key stats from this summer's storms and relevant history.

Highest reported rainfalls were from the Aug. 31 storm, which lasted about four hours.



10.5 inches fell in Sporting Hill.

9 inches fell in Mount Joy.

8 inches fell in Manheim.

RAIN TOTALS

Meteorologist Paul Head said rainfall measurements in Landisville were almost 20 inches from August, and roughly 34 inches fell through June, July and August.



Official Lancaster County measurements taken at Millersville showed August closed the third-wettest since records started in 1914; the highest was in 1933. The highest one-day total was June 22, 1972, during Tropical Storm Agnes.
